

The 1st Mill Creek Bicycle Race course will take place in the Village Center along Herrington Blvd., Ford Dr., Baker Dr. and N. Mill Creek Dr. (around the circle). The Start/Finish line will be on Herrington Boulevard across from the Mill Creek Market (map attached). Parking will NOT be allowed along the race course starting at 6:00 AM on Saturday, September 29th until the end of the last race, which will be approximately 1:00 PM. Course Marshals will be on hand at each intersection to assist residents during the races. We will begin setting-up the race course at 7:00 AM, with the first race schedule to begin at 9:00 AM (see schedule of races).

If you are unable to utilize your garage on the morning of the race, the Mill Creek Golf Club will allow you to park in their parking lot. If you do so, please use the east-side of the lot, away from the club house. Also, we have spoken with the U.S. Postal carrier and he has indicated all residents will receive their mail on the day of the race.
