Kane County to Host Public Hearings on County Apportionment Plan

Kane County Seeking Public Input on County Board Districts Map

GENEVA, IL – Kane County will hold two Public Hearings in November to gather community input on the County’s Apportionment Plan and proposed County Board Districts map.

Members of the public will be offered five minutes each to make public comments during the Public Hearings.

Reapportionment is required by state law to occur every ten years following the decennial U.S. Census to ensure that each County Board District represents a substantially equal number of people.

Kane County Board Chair Corinne Pierog said redistricting is vitally important to Kane County because it determines fair representation for Kane County’s 24 County Board Districts.

“I would like to thank the Kane County Reapportionment Task Force and County Board members, staff, the Kane County State’s Attorney’s Office and demographer consultants for their help to ensure that we have fair representation in all of our 24 County Board Districts,” states Chairman Pierog.

Each Public Hearing will be held in-person and livestreamed to the Kane County YouTube channel.

The two Public Hearings will take place at the following times, dates and locations:

- 6:00 p.m. Monday, November 15, 2021 – Seigle Auditorium (Building E Room 125), 1700 Spartan Drive, Elgin.
- 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, November 17, 2021 – Kane County Government Center (Building A) 719 S. Batavia Ave., Geneva.

The November 17th Public Hearing will also be conducted via Zoom. Zoom login information will be posted on the Kane County website homepage prior to the event at www.countyofkane.org.
