**Tree-trimming projects to briefly close portions of  
Elgin Prairie Path and Fox River Trail**

GENEVA, IL — Two tree-trimming projects will prompt intermittent closures of portions of the Elgin Prairie Path in Elgin and South Elgin, and the Fox River Trail in South Elgin, through June 30.

For each project, ComEd contractor Asplundh will remove any trees that are interfering with power lines, and trim back others that are close to utility lines.

The first project is along the Elgin Prairie Path from Raymond Street in Elgin to Middle Street in South Elgin. The trimming will begin on April 21 and is expected to be finished by May 28.

The second project is along the Fox River Trail between State Street in South Elgin and Villa Marie Road in Valley View. Asplundh will also be accessing the preserves connected by this trail at Jon J. Duerr Forest Preserve in South Elgin and Tekakwitha Woods Forest Preserve in St. Charles to continue trimming along the power lines that service the shelters and houses on-site. This project will start on May 17 and is expected to be finished by June 30.

The Forest Preserve District of Kane County asks trail users to be mindful of the projects, heavy machinery being used, and of the possibility of intermittent trail closures during the time frames indicated. Signs for the projects will be displayed at both ends of projects to alert trail users.
